LIVING POSITIVE VICTORIA ANNOUNCES RESIGNATION OF CEO

22 August 2017 – Brent Allan has resigned as Chief Executive Officer of Living Positive Victoria effective 22 August, 2017. Mr. Allan faithfully served the organisation for more than five years and championed tirelessly for the rights and wellbeing of all people living with HIV (PLHIV).

Living Positive Victoria President, Richard Keane, expressed his sincere thanks to Mr. Allan.

“It has been a privilege to work in partnership as President of this organisation with a CEO of the skills and calibre that Brent has,” said Keane.

“He has been an agent of change for our organisation. From rebranding the organisation from People Living with HIV/AIDS Victoria into Living Positive Victoria, to the development of the Positive Leadership Development Institute (PLDI) which has equipped more than 250 PLHIV from across Australia and New Zealand with resilience and leadership skills, and facilitating the successful merger of Straight Arrows and Living Positive Victoria late last year – he’s left an imprint that won’t be forgotten.”

Suzy Malhotra will serve as Acting Chief Executive Officer in the interim. The Living Positive Victoria Board of Directors will commence a search to fill the role in the coming months.
