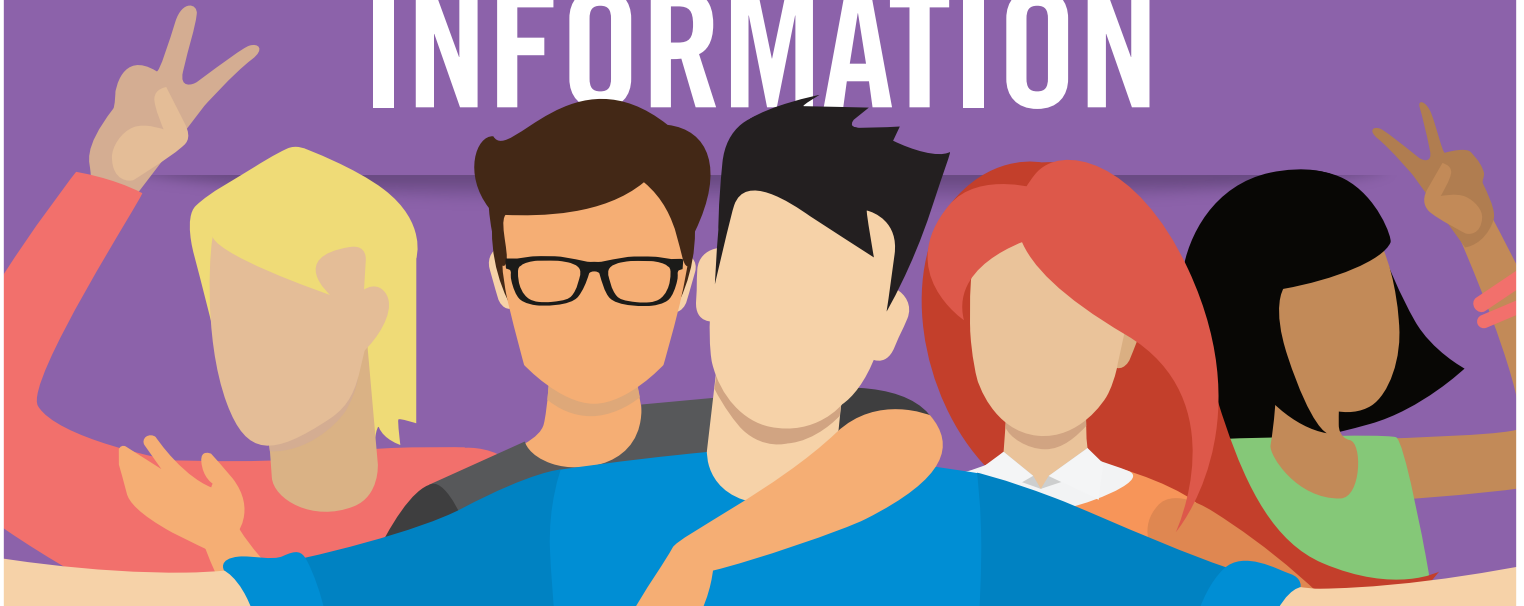


# SEXUAL HEALTH INFORMATION
